Participants will be able to sample these delicious treats following an Italian dinner honoring his home country. St. Francis is perhaps most known for his preaching to the birds. Therefore, following a reading of St. Francis' Canticle to the Sun, participants can choose to decorate a birdhouse and/or make a biodegradable birdfeeder with sunflower butter and birdseed.

**ACOLYTE TRAINING:** Today after 9:30 service! If your child is in 5<sup>th</sup> grade or above (s)he's invited to become an acolyte at St. Patrick's. Come to training immediately after the 9:30 service. There they'll learn all they need to know to become a Torchbearer. Becoming an acolyte is a great way to serve God in the church. If your child is older, (s)he will first learn to be a torchbearer, and then ascend up the acolyte roster as quickly as (s)he feels comfortable. Young people typically move up to Crucifer (usually 7<sup>th</sup> grade and up) and later Server (9<sup>th</sup> grade and up). You're welcome to attend this one-hour training along with your youngster, if you wish. Come join us to check out this ministry and see if it's right for your child. No obligation to serve if it doesn't appeal.
