St. Patrick's Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper

Menu: Pancakes, Waffles, Sausage, Scrambled Eggs, Potato Casserole, Fresh Fruit, Gluten Friendly Pancakes.

Cost: \$8.00 for Adults/\$4.00 for Kids (10 and under)

Youth Confirmation Retreat February 28-29, 2020. We will leave St. Patrick's at 5:00pm for the Procter Center and return to the church by 8pm Saturday evening. This retreat is an opportunity to take some time away from life's everyday concerns and commitments and be intentional with God and one another. The program is designed for our young confirmands to reflect on and respond to what they are being taught through catechesis and consider what they truly believe. Confirmands are expected to attend.

This summer the Youth of St. Patrick's ages 12+ in grades 6-12 will be returning to the Appalachian South Folklife Center in West Virginia.
