Paul's Letter to the Philippians Wisdom for Anxious Times

Join on Sundays starting Sept. 18th thru Oct. 16th at 11:00 a.m. in person at the church for this video series from NT Wright about Paul's Letter to the Philippians. Describing the course he writes:

This is a time of great anxiety worldwide, and it may be that by looking together at a letter Paul wrote out of great anxiety we may be able to find our way to fresh hope. Paul wasn't pretending times were easy. He speaks about the possibility of having one sorrow on top of another (Philippians 2.27). So when he says 'Don't worry about anything' (4.6) we know that this didn't come easy for him. He himself he had to work at it constantly.

In addition to hearing short talks from Bp. Wright, there will be plenty of time for discussion and reflection.
